International Initiatives on Collaborative Learning

Teacher Education and Professional Development



Hosted by The University Of Fukui, Japan

The Fukui Roundtable is held semi-annually in February and June. The Roundtable consists of five zones (A, B, C, D, E). Zone D International provides a platform for collaborative learning on practices and future prospects for teacher education reform inside and outside Japan.

The University of Fukui has been accepting a large number of foreign students who are engaged in teacher education through collaborative learning and has been maintaining its ties with the past foreign students by inviting them to the Roundtable to share their previous and current practices with practitioners from different countries. Moreover, since 2021, as part of its global development, the University of Fukui has been focusing on the Nalikule College of Education and its demonstration school in the Republic of Malawi and following the process of their reflective lesson study.

This Zone will consist of two sessions; Symposium and “Roundtable.” In the symposium, the symposiasts will discuss the proposed approaches, results, and challenges in their contexts. In the “Roundtable,” educators from various countries will share their practice and learn from each other in small group discussions. We hope that these examples will encourage you to reflect upon your own practices. These sessions will also be translated into Japanese.

Zone Dでは、実践における協働的な学びのプラットフォームを提供し、国内外の教員養成の展望を拓くことを目的とし、世界各国の教育関係者と実践や学びを共有し、捉え直しを行っています。福井大学教職大学院では、世界各国からの留学生を受け入れています。福井ラウンドテーブルでは、探究型学習を通じた教師教育を受けた留学生が帰国後の授業実践の報告も行っています。加えて、2021年からは、福井大学が行っているマラウイ共和国のナリクレ教員養成大学及び附属高校と協働・連携し、子ども中心の授業や協働探究学習について語り合ってきました。今回も引き続き、世界各国の様々な実践を聴き合う中でより良い子どもたちの学びについて探ります。このZoneにおいてはシンポジウムでの事例紹介とラウンドテーブルでの議論を通して、参加者自身の実践と省察が深まることが期待されます。なお、本セッションは英語での議論となりますが、日-英の通訳を行いますので、ご希望の方は、申し込みの際に通訳希望としていただき、当日は通訳用のZoomに接続するためのデバイスを別途ご用意ください。
