

International Initiatives on Teacher Education Reform: Different Approaches to ‘Reflective Lesson Study’

In 2016, the United Graduate School of Teachers’ Professional Development, University of Fukui was commissioned to conduct JICA Knowledge Co-Creation Program (KCCP) on Lesson Study, and since then, we have continuously accepted requests for teacher training from Singapore, Thailand, Egypt, and Saudi Arabia. Given the above background, at the Fukui February roundtable in 2021, we launched Zone D International to provide a forum for collaborative reflection on practices and future prospects for teacher education reform overseas.

In the June round table, we focused on the Nalikule College of Education and its demonstration school in the Republic of Malawi and followed the process of their reflective lesson study. We realized how crucial it is to work on it from a long-term perspective through practice and reflection. Therefore, in February round table, we will continuously follow the progress of their reflective lesson study practice.

This zone will consist of two sessions; symposium and forum. In the symposium, the symposiast will discuss the approaches, results, and challenges of lesson study at Nalikule College of Education and its demonstration school. In the forum, educators from other African countries who participated in JICA KCCP will share their reflective lesson study practice and learn from each other in small group discussions. We hope that the African example will stimulate you to reflect upon your own practices. These sessions will be conducted in English and translated to Japanese.

2021年6月のラウンドテーブルに引き続き、マラウイ共和国のナリクレ教員養成大学及びその附属学校に着目し、省察的授業研究の取り組みの過程を追っていくことにします。今回のシンポジウムでも、ナリクレ教員養成大学及び附属学校における授業研究の取り組みや成果、課題等について話題を提供して頂きます。またフォーラムでは、JICA 課題別研修参加者の話題提供を踏まえ、参加者がそれぞれの校種や領域で具体的に実践を捉え直していきます。アフリカの事例を通して、各国での実践を捉えなおす場になればと思います。

なお、本セッションは全て英語で実施しますが、今回から試験的に通訳を行う予定です。通訳をご希望の参加者はパソコンやタブレット等、通訳用の Zoom に参加するためのデバイスを別途用意下さい。また、Forumsでは通訳者数の関係から、通訳を希望される場合グループの人数が多くなる場合があります。
