

## International Initiatives on Collaborative Learning: Teacher Education and Professional Development

The Fukui Roundtable is held semi-annually in February and June. The Roundtable consists of five zones (A, B, C, D, E). Zone D International provides a platform for collaborative learning on practices and future prospects for teacher education reform inside and outside Japan.

Since 2021, as part of its global development, the University of Fukui has been focusing on the Nalikule College of Education and its demonstration school in the Republic of Malawi and following the process of their reflective lesson study. Moreover, since 2015 the University of Fukui has been accepting a large number of foreign students who were/are engaged in teacher education through collaborative learning and has been maintaining its ties with the past foreign students by inviting them to the Roundtable to share their previous and current practices with practitioners from different countries.

This Zone will consist of two sessions; Symposium and “Roundtable”. In the symposium, the symposiasts will discuss the proposed approaches, results, and challenges in their contexts. In the “Roundtable”, educators from various countries will share their practice and learn from each other in small group discussions. We hope that these examples will stimulate you to reflect upon your own practices. These sessions will also be translated into Japanese.

Zone D では、実践における協働的な学びのプラットフォームを提供し、国内外の教員養成の展望を拓くことを目的とし、世界各国の教育関係者と実践や学びを共有し、捉え直しを行っています。

2021 年からは、福井大学が行っているマラウイ共和国のナリクレ教員養成大学及び附属高校との協働と連携して実施しています。加えて 2022 年 6 月からは、福井大学教職大学院で学び、帰国後授業研究に取り組んでいる実践の報告も行っています。そこでは、子ども中心の授業や協働探究学習について語り合ってきました。今回も引き続き、様々な実践を聴き合う中でより良い子どもたちの学びについて探ります。この Zone での事例紹介と議論を通して、参加者自身の実践と省察が深まることを期待しています。
